

# THE REPORT OF 14<sup>TH</sup> APBC IN CHONGQING CHINA

The 14th APBC was held at Chongqing Yuzhong Hotel, Chongqing, China from September 13th – 16th, 2023. There are about 1060 delegates attended the congress, including 160 overseas experts and 900 local delegates. The sponsor of this Congress is the Institute of Burn Research, Southwest Hospital, Third Military Medical University.
